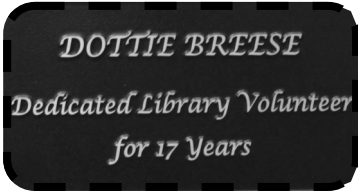

Endcap Plaque

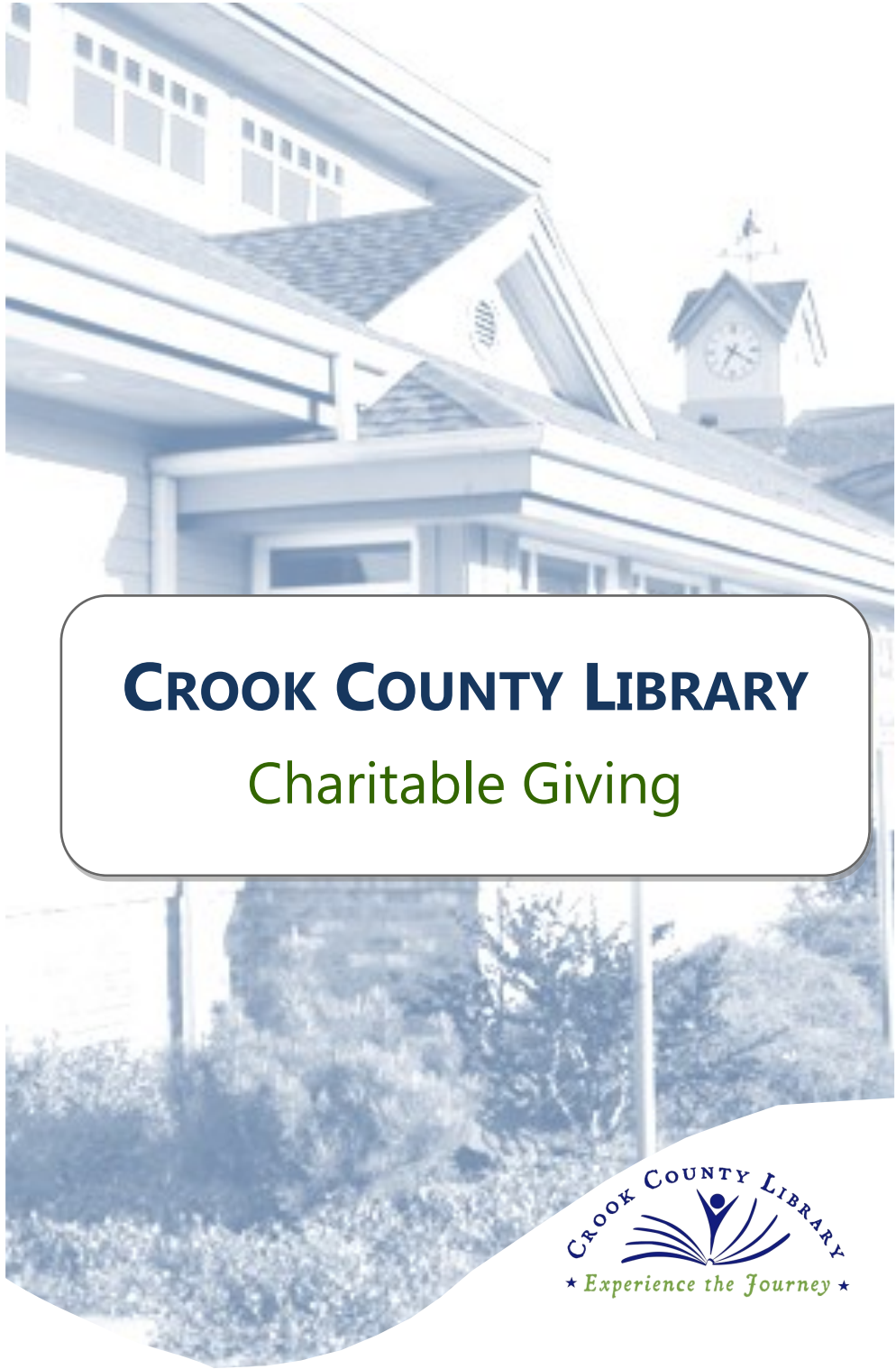

Ways to Give

Recognition Gifts The library welcomes monetary gifts for purchase of materials for the collection, given in recognition of individuals or organizations. Library staff will select items that match the donor's subject preferences when possible, and in adherence to the library's Collection Development Policy. The name of the person to be recognized and the donor will be listed on a bookplate attached to the item(s), if requested by the donor (see back of brochure).

Financial Donations Unrestricted gifts of money are gratefully accepted by the library to be used at its discretion, in the form of cash, checks, or stock. Unrestricted funds allow the library to support special purchases of equipment and materials and to set aside money for long-term projects.

Bequests Charitable bequests are gifts of any property (real or cash) made by naming the library as a beneficiary in a person's will. This is a simple method for donors to make a planned gift to the library and to contribute to sustaining and enriching the library's services to the community for generations to come. An individual interested in including the library in their estate planning should consult with their attorney and the library director to formulate appropriate terms.
