- **Record Number 217-25-000066-PLNG:** Crook County Code Amendments
 - The proposed amendments establish a new military training route overlay zone requiring notice to the Department of Defense and consultation on potential encroachments. The proposal is to also update land use tables in the EFU and Forest zones and amend requirements for transmission lines and cell towers to reference the new overlay zone. Additionally, the amendments propose to modify commercial renewable energy rules to align with HB 2329, add pre-application consultation requirements with multiple agencies, and update the comprehensive plan to incorporate military overlay zone maps and text.

- **Record Number 217-24-000198-PLNG:** A Conditional Use Permit
 - Application to allow mining, crushing, and stockpiling of materials at the site, located at 7950 NW Lone Pine Road, Terrebonne, OR, adjacent to an existing 9-acre permitted area. The property is zoned Exclusive Farm Use (EFU2). The Board of County Commissioners approved adding the site to the Comprehensive Plan Goal 5 aggregate resource list; this continuation is for deliberations only on the conditional use proposal.
